




DESIGN INSPIRATION

Whether as a console, coffee table or elegant slender bench (with optional cushion), the 'Bimu' by Dutch designer Bart Vos is a versatile piece of furniture. Of course, you can dress the 'Bimu' with favourite books, a piece of art or a statement lamp, but even without any adornment, 'Bimu' is utterly beautiful. The masterly application of the liquidambar wood veneer underlines its ostensibly simple construction, whereas the richness of the grain is enhanced by (optional) stains and varnishes.

DESIGNED BY BART VOS

Talk about design being part of your genetic makeup: his father was renowned designer Henk Vos, one of his brothers is equally renowned designer Roderick Vos. As a matter of fact, Bart Vos is preceded by no less than three generations of furniture makers. It was only a couple of years since Bart graduated from the Royal Academy of Art in The Hague, when his father asked him—aged just 24 at the time—to design the ground-breaking Maupertuus building for the Vos emporium in Groningen. Today, Bart is Vos Interieur's creative director, responsible for interior design projects in the Netherlands and abroad. And he regularly turns his hand to furniture, for various international brands, including Linteloo. His awareness of and interest in 'the real world', outside the confines of a showroom or studio, shine through in his designs: extremely beautiful yet utterly useable.



SPECIFICATIONS

Material: Liquidambar veneer on a plywood base.

Cushion: polyurethane foam, wrapped in hypoallergenic polyester fibre, 100% cotton inner cover.

Origin: Hand made in The Netherlands

OPTIONS

Finish: Natural or stained green, red or blue. All colourways available with either a matt or gloss varnish.

Cushion: Cushions are available for both the 4m and 2m bench, in all fabrics and leathers from the LINTELOO collection. Customers can opt to supply their own choice of upholstery fabric/leather. MAINTENANCE

All LINTELOO furniture has been made with love and care. Of course, we want you to enjoy it, for as long as possible. Proper maintenance will prolong its lifespan, which is why each piece of LINTELOO furniture comes with a maintenance instruction booklet, also available for download at linteloo.com Detailed information on care and cleaning, including the recommended products, can also be found at linteloo-care.nl

Wood veneer: Simply wipe down with a damp cloth for easy cleaning. Do not use abrasives or silicon-based lustre agents. A veneered table cannot be sanded/refinished.

WARRANTY

All LINTELOO sofas and chairs are backed by a 10-year warranty on the frame. Cushions, upholstery and all other LINTELOO products are backed by a 3-year warranty, with a depreciation of 1/3 each year. Please make sure you keep your invoice or receipt. Excluded from the warranty are:

- Regular wear and tear, damages and discolouration of upholstery (fabric and/or leather).
- Creasing, colour and structure variations and other irregularities, which are part of the natural characteristics of fabrics, leather and/ or wood.
- Complaints regarding fabrics and/or leathers which are not part of the standard LINTELOO collection (specially supplied fabrics and/or leathers).
